## PRINCESS TOURS ANTIGUA.

Princess Hargaret is escorted by Sir Kenneth Blackburne, the Governor of the Leeward Islands, when she attends a garden party held in her honeur. This takes place on the island of Antigua, one of the Leeward group to which Her Royal Highmess journeyed from Barbades in the reyal gacht Britannia.

And then it is the children's moment. At Savannah, the Princess drives past more than 6,000 boys and girls, most of whom wear the uniform of a Girl Guide or Scout. It is here that some of the island's major arisket matches are held, in the eyes of the spectators is reflected the fielding of these people towards the Royal Tour.
