Viscount Hambleden leaves the Church of Santa Maria in Dominica with his bride, Donna Maria de Adelfia, the daughter of a former Ambassador in Moscow and Berlin. Because the groom is a Protestant, special dispensation was granted by the Pope for the marriage. About 300 guests, and almost as many photographers, surge forward as the couple leave. After a week's honeymoon in Sicily, they are journeying on for a short stay in Rio de Janeiro.

On Formosa, Chiang Kai-Chek vows all-out fight to hold the islands of Quemoy and Matsu. He also denounces proposals for a cease-fire, saying such arrangements never stop aggression but only divert it elsewhere.

Mr. Ben-Gurion, the former Israeli Prime Minister, has been living as a shepherd for the last fourteen months in a desert settlement. Now the 69 year old leader returns to politics from his almost hermit-like existence to take up the post of Defence Minister in Jerusalem.
