Banghok, the chief city and port of Sian, becomes the meeting place for the Council of the South East Asian Treaty Organization. This vital get-together is warmly welcomed by the local people, crowds of when turn out to demonstrate their good-will towards the delegator.

Mr. Foster Bulles, the American Secretary of State, arrives at the Assembly Hall. Then, in a Hells Royce, comes Sir Anthony Hen, Britain's Foreign Secretary. These two delegates are undoubtedly the most important figures in the talks. Sir Anthony Eden has a ticklish job ahead to reconcile Angle-American policy in the Par East.

Mr. Casey propresents Australia at the meetings. Subversive activities in South East Asia are discussed vigorously and there is a wide measure of agreement on those dangers. But the key problem of Formosa still looms large for the American and British delegates. Once again, Sir Anthony Eden must exercise his powers of diplomacy to the full.
