22nd February, 1955. Plus X. Cameraman: G. Meng Kwee. Malayan Film Unit.

Various shots of arrival of Mr. Dulles arriving by plane at Don Muang Airport, Bangkok. Shaking hands with Thai officials. U.S. and Thai flags flying, etc. Then Mr. and Mrs. Dulles enter car and depart.

22nd Feb: Arrival of Sir Anthony Eden at Airport (night) and departure. Cameraman: Low, M.F.D. 200 ft. Eyemo. (Met by Thailand's Foreign Minister.) 23rd Peb: Cameraman: Low. 630 ft. (5 rolls shot in poor light). (Rolls 3 to 7 P.X.) Shots of crowds lining roadside leading to Assembly Hall. Cars arriving. Eden walks into hall. Sits with the Commissioner General, Malaya. (? MacDonald.) Shots of Chief Delegates. Roll 4 includes shots of Prime Minister PHIBUN SONGKRAM.

Rolls 5, 6 and 7 include shots of various delegates who can be identified by their Desk Plates. The Pakistan Delegate is the one who is seen smoking a cigarette. The Thai Delegate (who was also elected Chairman) is seen dressed in white addressing the assembly. He looks Chinese and has thinning hair. Shots also include some cutaways, which can be distinguished from the Delegates.

24th Feb. Cameraman Low. 300 ft. P.X. Scenes shot include (1) British car with flag; (2) Pakistani car; (3) Eden's car; (4) Assembly Hall scenes (Roll 1.)

Roll 2: Welcome Arch and scenes of Bangkok. Roll 3: Various scenes of Bangkok. (All Eyemo.) All above in two consignments. Approx. 1, 300 ft. Undeveloped negative. May be slight judder in roll No. 2 on 22nd Feb. due to emulsion slight sticking to sides of gate.
