THE FALCON-NEW U.S. MISSILE,

The American Air Force introduces the Falcon rocket, the latest addition to their range of guided missiles. The lethal little weapon is fixed under the wing of a high-speed interceptor 'plane ready for firing in flight. An artist's impression shows how it works.

Now an actual demonstration of the missile. Radar, inside the parent 'plane, sights the target. Then the six-foot, hundred pound rocket is fired. The Falcon, which has a range of about five miles, guides itself to the target.

Now a second demonstration of the tiny missile which is claimed to carry a punch big enough to knock out any enemy aircraft carrying an H-Bomb. With the Falcon, the Air Force hopes to deliver that punch long before any such plane crosses the American coast.
