LIVINGSTONE HONOURED.

At Blantyre, seven miles from Glasgow, was born the great Scotsman David Livingstone. Now his great-great grandson, Dr. Livingstone Wilson, visits the birth place which is now a permanent memorial to the missionary and explorer. About 70,000 people come here every year to view the relics of Dr. Livingstone's life in Africa. They include a model of the Bush hut in which he died.

Perhaps the greatest moment of Livingstone's life in Africa was his discovery of the mighty Victoria Falls. He came upon them while following the Zambesi, taking God's word into the very heart of the continent. Now his descendent, also a medical missionary in Africa, pays tribute to "Scotland's Greatest Son".
