TURNER'S MATERIAL.

At Guildhall Rolls 1, 2 & 3.

Procession of: Floral Cross escorted by children of Guildford Sunday Schools.

Bishop of Guildford with visiting Bishops.

Mayor and corporation of Guildford and Civic Dignitaries of neighbouring parishes.

Medieval pilgrims.

Modern Pilgrims from each parish processing in deanery groups with banners etc

Princess arrives at Guildhall - met by Lord Lieutenant and Mayor of Guildford.

Princess inspects Guard of Honour (Queen's Royal Regiment)

Princess meets Town Clerk.

Princess ~~leaves~~ leaves for Service.Rolls 4 & 5

Shots of Princess Margaret in Cathedral, viewing the Interior, seeing a model of how the Cathedral will look when finished, signing visitors book and signing a Brick, unveiling a Stone commemorating her visit and walking thro' Archways.

RICHARDSON'S MATERIAL. ROLL ONE - Arrival of the Pilgrims along Guildford By-Pass - G.V.'s on site filling up - Cross arrives - G.V. of procession - On Horseback as in days of old -

ROLL TWO - Arrival in G.V. of Princess Margaret - Walking through the crowds - towards dais.

ROLL THREE - G.V. on Service - G.V. Guildford - Procession moves away after service towards Cathedral. - Princess walks towards Cathedral - Through Window down to where Princess is.
