Doctor Jonas Salk, discoverer of the first successful vaccine against infantile paralysis, gives the first official reports to a waiting world at the University of Michigan.

Dr. Salk's own child was one of the two million children involved in tests of his vaccine - tests which have ended for all time the threat of one of the world's most vicious diseases. Doctors Francis and O'Connor have been close collaborators in the vaccine's development.

Dr. Francis personally carried out the extensive experiments with the help of Canadian laboratories and it will be developed further ---
