OPERATION CUE PEATURES AN ATOMIC BLAST TO TEST CERTAIN DEVICES AND TO ASSIST CIVIL DEFENSE PERSONALL WITH FIRST HAND INFORMATION ON THE POWERS FULL WEPONX AND ITS EFFECT ON ARDINARY HOMES, BUILDINGS AND EQUIPTMENT FOUND IN AN ADVERAGE CITY IN AMERICA. DOON TOWN, BUILT TO BE BLASTED IS SITUATED ON YUCGA FLATS INTHE DESERT LAND OF NEVADA. ITS BUILDINGS ARE OF ALL DIFFERNT TYPE CONSTRUCTION, AND THEY ARE STOCKED WITH FOOD AND FURNITURE AND APPLIANCES, AS WELL AS MANNEQUINS SIMULATING THE FAMILIESDWELLING WITHIN. Angles of the detection teams at work. C.U. of the men, showing plastic covers over rubber boots and over the probes and counters, over radio antennaes on their backs, etc. Results of preliminary check are brought to officers and they, with American officers, look it over. Angles of Canadian officers with name patch over to radiation check chart. Officers watch the men in the distance, with a pair of binoculars. Angle same. C.U. man with protective clothing approaching camera. C.U. red flag on front of radiation jeep, pan over to Canadian license. C.U. License. A U.S. jeep, contaminated with radiation dust present in in dangerous quantity, is checked and then sprayed with high pressure water. Angle this. Angles of spray bath to remove contamination.
