

DUKE OF GLOUCESTER TOURS
WAR GRAVES.

The Duke of Gloucester, on a tour of British war graves in Italy, comes to Anzio - near the site of the memorable beachhead where more than 3,000 men lost their lives. Earl Alexander accompanies the Duke on an inspection of the Anzio War Cemetery.

The famous Montecassino Hill - for so long an obstacle in the British advance on Rome - looks down on the Cassino graves of some 4,00 British and Commonwealth men who were killed in that bitter campaign during the winter of 1943-44. Then, the monastery was in ruins - but eleven years have passed: time to rebuild, but not forget.
