GEOFF DUKE WINS GRAND PRIX.

International motor cycle aces whip away for the start of the French Grand Prix over thirty laps of the famous Reims circuit. In the lead throughout the 250 kilometre race is world champion Geoff Duke on a Gilera.

In a terrific race, Duke beats last year's lap record of 183.68 kilometres an hour (set up by Pierre Monneret) and sets a new one of 187.96.
