Twelve years later, to the day,

May the 16th, on the anniversary

of the Dam Busters raid some of

those most concerned have been

brought together. Gathered

here are the man who had the idea,

and the men who carried it out.

And there are the women who

waited at home. And perhaps there

are the shadows of those who

never came back.

Barnes Wallis, the man who designed the Wellington bomber, was the man who had the brilliant conception of bombing the German dams and flooding the industrial Ruhr. And he was the man who made the gigantic five-ton bombs to do the job. The day before the war began he left his wife and two daughters (very young they were then) to join the war effort.
