OF SWEDEN.

King Gustav and Queen Louise of Sweden are accompanied by Countess Mountbatten and the First Lord of the Admiralty Mr. J.P.L. Thomas, when (with Admiral Lord Mountbatten) they visit the Royal Naval College Greenwich.

Their Majesties are entertained at dinner by the Royal Navy's Board of Admiralty, Lord Louis (The Swedish Queen's brother) is an honoured guest.
