

AUSTRIA V. SCOTLAND.

Pennants are exchanged when Scotland meet Austria again in a soccer international at Vienna. Scotland, in dark shirts, kick off and start a sweeping movement upfield.

The visitor's attack shows beautiful combination as the ball is passed on by centre forward Reilly to keep up the run. Laurie Reilly gets it back again, this time to centre for Robertson's neat flick into goal. Perfect teamwork made it, putting Scotland one up within one minute.

Finally police are brought onto restore order - a most unsavoury scene on a sporting field.

Even members of the Scottish team seem about to be attacked before police manage to quieten the stormy crowds and some sort of order is restored.

After resuming, Younger has to jump for it and is

Lyddell shoots and Schmied dives in vain for Scotland's third goal.

Austria on the attack now and the ball goes out to their inside left Prebst who runs towards goal to win a free kick from Kerr's tackle, as he is brought down.

Oewirk, takes it - and the ball goes in off Docherty - Austria's first!

With the score 3-1, Scotland keep up the pressure Lyddell in particular playing a great game. After passing back to centre, Lyddell gets in position to receive it again and place it for Reilly's headed goal.

And four-one is the final score, a great victory for Scotland.
