Camerons march on. Queen and Duke arrive on Parade - Queen and Duke walk back from Inspection.

G.V.'s of Saluting Base and Quick troop.

Shots of the Old Colours trooped and marched off.

Shots of Queen and Duke on Dais.

Queen hands over the Colours - close and General.

Colours are marched to centre of Battalion.

Shots of the March Past, Queen on Dais. etc.,

One shot of Prince Charles at Window of Castle (asked not to take afterwards).

Queen talks to members of Regimental Association. Duke talks to same.

HANSHAW'S MATERIAL - 300'

ROLL ONE - Troops march on to Balmoral ~~XXXX~~ lawn. Queens walks to inspect parade - Band troops slow time.

ROLL TWO - Old Colur is trooped to Centre - Trooping old Colour down ranks Old Colour is marched off - Queen and Duke on Dais.

ROLL THREE - Queen walks to present New Colours . Presentation of New colours - Queen addresses troops - New Colour marched to centre. March Past.

ROLL FOUR - G.V. of March past - Battalion advances in review order - 3 cheers for the Queen - C.U. of dais.
