FISHER'S MATERIAL.

This Sunderland, carrying 14, crashed while landing off Eastbourne pier. The aircraft was to have been at Eastbourne in connection with the R.A.F.A. Conference. 4 killed.
Three badly injured members of the crew being brought ashore, half an hour after the crash.
Crowd and ambulances at Pier.
Scenes on beach as helicopter circle overhead.
The aircraft is towed to the beach by ~~WOODHURST~~ Eastbourne lifeboat and the vessel watched by large crowds.
Holiday crowds lend a hand to haul the aircraft inshore.
