The Chariet Festival, one of the most secred of Hindu rites, smalls the tiny village of Purio with more than half a million pilgrims. They seem to sarn admission to heaven by pulling the great temple - throne of Juggermant, God of the people, through the streets to the deity's country house a mile away.

Logard has it that pilgrims once throw themselves under the charist's whoels as a living sacrifice, but to devout Hindus this would be sacrilege in a festival sacred to Vishma, the Preserver.

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
