RONCHAMP NEW CHURCH Exclusive Positive developed: 6 20 meters = 70 ft

LeCONBUSIER, French world famous architect, known for his revolutionary views and dessigns in modern architecture has built his first religious masterpiece, the Church of RONCHAMPS, site of traditional pilgrinage in the south-end of the Vesges, upon the ruins of 3Notre-Dame-du-Haut" which was destroyed in 1944 during the liberation battle.

The church which was descigned in one spirt by LE CORBUSIER and which evokes the byzantine Basilies of Istambul, is in full harmony with the four horizons surrounding the Ronchamp hilltop. LE CORBUSIER himself has surveyed the building with workers and decorators but refused to explain his choice of symbols used in this first Sacrod-Art realization of his.

It was built in I8 months. Its revolutionary conception brings numerous tourists and people to the site surrounded by one of the most wonderful landscapes of this lovely part of France.

This coverage was made on a Sunday morning when the faithfuls flock uphill to the new Pilgrinage church of Netro-Dame du Haut (Our Lady of the Top.)
