BRITISH SHOW JUMPING TEAM 1955

Miss Dawn Palethorpe and Lady Mary Rose Williams who are competing at present in the International Horse Show at Aachen, as members of the British Team, will be returning by air on Monday 11th July. They are due to arrive at London Airport by Flight L.H. 130 at 11.50 a.m.

This is Miss Palethorpe's first tour abroad and she has been outstandingly successful. At the International Horse Show at Paris she was equal 1st in the qualifying rounds of the Grand Prix, besides being placed 2nd in several other competitions. At the Rhine Army Horse Show she won the Championship and two other competitions and to date at Aachen she has won the Puissance and Ladies Championship.

Miss Palethorpe will, of course, be taking part in the International Horse Show which takes place from the 18th to 23rd July at the White City Stadium. She must undoubtedly be one of the favourites for the Queen Elizabeth II Cup, which is the Ladies Individual Championship and which takes place on the evening of Tuesday 19th July.
