BELGIAN CATHOLICS STAGE MASS PROFEST:

In stifling summer heat, a quarter of a million Bolgian Catholies march through the streets of Brussels to protest against the Government's Binostien Bill, now being considered by the Bolgian Senate.

The demonstration is erganised by the Christian Social Party, who claim that the Bill, with its limitations on the subsidising of private schools, is a "deadly menace" to Catholic edmonstrators. The demonstrators carrying beamers urging the Senate to vote "No" murch past Party chief Theo Lefevre, and other Catholic Leaders.

Government supporters say the bill will restore the balance between State and Catholic schools. But though follings run high, both Parties have agreed to ban counter-demonstrations.
