250,000 DEMONSTRATE IN BRUSSELS
Positive Unamed OPED : 43 meters - I45 ft

DEVECOPED

In a protest against the Roman Catholic School policy of the Liberal Socialist condition government of Premier Achille van Acher, an estimated 250,000 entholics throughd Brussels yerterday.

The visitors came from all over the country, and many people fainted on the sidewalks during the demonstration, because of heat. The demonstrators carried anti-government posters and shouted slogans opposing the draft bill on education submitted to the Senate, after approval by Socialist House of Representatives, by Socialist Minister of Education Lee Collard. A group of demonstrators was seen carrying the traditional pirates black flag of revelt. Similar flags hung from many churches in the Flanders area.

Mr. Theo LEFEVRE, head of Social Christian Party who had organized this mass demonstration was standing on the Stock Exchange stairs with officials of his party and representatives of Outholis organizations, while the parade went on for over four hours.

Although the demonstration was authorized by the Burgmeter of Brussels, geminraerie massel at strategie points of the capital were ready, but did not have to intervene.

last Mrch 26 a similar Ontholic demonstration was benned. Some incidents occurred between demonstrators and police. Re avoid new incidents, Catholic and Socialist leaders agreed last month on a three-month truce, during which none of the opposing parties would stage any demonstration against the other. So far the truce has been respected on both sides.

The draft bill prevides for control of the opening of new private schools, cuts certain subsides to free(Catholic) education, establishes strict conditions to the subsidising of private education and plans a series of measures which, according to Catholic spokesmen, are "deadly meases" to Catholic education in Belgium. Satholic spokesmen further claim the bill aims at destroying the Catholic School system, while pro government voices say that it will re-establing the balance between official and Catholic schools, a balance, they claim, which was broken in favor of Satholic education by former Social Christian Minister of Bineation, Pierre Harmel.
