ROLL I

Various shots at Airport showing the strict security visitors (male and female) being searched and papers being examined before entry is permitted - also shots of soldiers.

ROLL II

All photographers (and there are hundreds of them) are kept well back from the arrival point - pan from line up to Viscount taking in with the Prime Minister and Lady Eden on board. Various lenses during arrival.

ROLL III (H.P.3)

M. Faure and M. Pinay arrive. Crowds line streets for Eisenhower's arrival - shots from car. (I decided to go to the American villa at CREUX DE CHEVIGNON to get the arrival of Eisenhower but the light was very very bad and don't think it will be much use)

Mr. & Mrs. Eisenhower arrive at the villa - smoky shots in the bad light.

ROLL IV

Soviet Members arrive at Airport - long lens on airfield and driving shot on way to their villa. Mr. & Mrs. Eisenhower driving into their villa (after going to Church)

ROLL V

Smoky G.V.S of Palais des Nations and G.V.S. of Geneva.

Various lenses interior of conference room with clearer shots of delegates (all had to be taken from the balcony).

GENEVA CONFERENCE

For the "Summit" Conference beginning to-day in Geneva, the Government chiefs of USSR, United States, Great Britain and France arrived, in turn on Cointrin-Geneva airport.

First to arrive was Mr. Anthony Eden, and Lady Eden. They were greeted by Mr. PETITPIERRE, President of the Swiss Confederation, who accompanied Sir Anthony in the review of the Guard of Honor and then to a battery of microphone and press photographers, parked a distance from the airstrip.

Sir Anthony listened to Mr. Petitpierre's greeting words and answered him as per this sound coverage

then arrived Messrs Edgar FAURE French Premier, accompanied by Mr. Antoine Pinay Foreign Minister,

Then President Eisenhower, with Mrs. Eisenhower, and finally yesterday morning USSR' Boulganine, accompanied by Marshall Jukov.

The same ceremonial was used for each Chief of State who reviewed the guard of honor while the national anthems were played, then made a declaration at the microphone in answer to Mr. Petitpierre's greeting words.
