In a four thousand ten steel sphere — twenty stories high — America's

first atomic electricity for commercial use is ready to course through

transmission lines to homes and industries in northeastern New York

State.

On a flag-draped stage, AEC chairman Strauss throws a switch illuminating, symbolically, the world's largest light bulb.

A steam generator — powered by atomic energy — sends out enough electricity to serve a city of thirty thousand persons. Put right to work by the first family on the line, hamburgers — from an atomic electric stove — are tasty testimonials of things to some in the atomic age!
