WINEGROWERS FEAST IN VEVEY (Switzerland)

One every 25 years, the winegrowers Feast in Vevey takes a special importance and never before was it as wonderfully organized as this year.

The small town has built a special Arena which can house 16,000 persons, and over 4000 actors, singers and dancers are taking part in the special spectacle given every day for several days. This show goes on for four hours and was produced by Maurice Lehman, director of Paris Opera, music from Carlo Hemmerling with costumes designed by Henri R. Fost and dancers and singers from all over Switzerland and Paris (450 in all).
