DOMINICI CASE REOPENED.

Three years after the murder of the Drummond family, for which farmer Gaston Dominici was sentenced to death, French police reopen the case with an on-the-spot reconstruction of the crime. Seventy-seven year old Dominici, from his prison cell, continues to protest his innocence of the slaying of Sir Jack Drummond and his wife and daughter.

Now the Ministry of Justice has ordered a re-investigation and from the Surete, France's Scotland Yard, top homicide expert Commissioner Charles Chenevier, brings a team to start again from the beginning.

To the public of both Britain and France, the Drummond case has always seemed full of unanswered questions. Two nations hope that this new inquiry will clear up a tragic mystery once and for all.
