

AIR CRASH VICTIMS' FUNERAL

Fifty-eight victims of a tragic disaster are brought to Israel for a mass funeral, attended by Commonwealth and other foreign representatives. The 58 lost their lives when Bulgarian fighters shot down an Israeli airliner near the Bulgarian frontier.

Bulgaria, expressing her regret at the catastrophe, announced she would pay compensation and punish those responsible. But if European tension is to be relaxed, such disasters, must be prevented. Neither regret nor compensation can bring back to life the innocent victims who now lie in a common grave - Jew, Catholic and Protestant side by side.
