ATOMS FOR PEACE.

Sixteen hundred scientists from over 70 countries gather in Geneva to discuss the peaceful uses of atomic energy, under Conference President Professor Bhabha of India and U.N. Secretary General Hammarskjöld.

During his opening speech, Professor Bhabha points out that small nations, also, may soon have the means to make nuclear weapons, and he sounds this note of warning to the conference:

With limitless power under his control, man must learn to control control himself.
