Tension rises as demonstrators gather at Belgaum near the border between India and the tiny Portuguese colony of Goa. Thousands plan to celebrate India's Independence Day by marching into the colony to demand an end to Portuguese rule.

Goa has been Portuguese for four and a half centuries, but since India won her independence from British rule, feelings have reached boiling point over this last European possession. Marching through no-man's land these anti-Portuguese demonstrators, are staging the biggest protest yet. But as they reach the frontier, Portuguese police open fire.

The demonstrators try to crawl forward, but the police are still firing.

Over a dozen dead, and many injured. How many more will die before India and Portugal settle their differences?
