U.S. BUILDS "WEATHER ISLANDS".

Rising out of the ocean a hundred miles off America's Atlantic coast, a series of radar and weather stations are being built at a cost of a million dollars each. Apart from their military uses, they remind us that America knows from bitter experience the need of a constant watch on the offshore weather.

Thirty men will be stationed on these platforms, which are constructed on piles on shallow parts of the ocean bed. There will be room for helicopter landings, too, on these new ocean outposts.
