The Prime Minister began his tour of the Fighting Services
with a visit of Farnberough Air Show, where he boarded an Avro
Vulcan, one of Fritain's latest V-Bombers. During the flight Sir
Anthony took the controls and saw for homself the impressive
performance of this fine aircraft.

A more listancely transport brought the Frime Minister to Colchester on a visit to Army Units there. Major-General Harding, Commander East Anglia District was there to greet him.

After inspecting a Guard of Honour mounted by R.E.M.E. Sir
Anthony saw how the modern Army is preparing to counter an atomic
