The presentation of portrait by the Confederation of the Cinque ~~XXXXX~~ Ports.

1. General view inside the White Rock Pavilion where the Confederation of the Cinque Ports hold their Court and where the portrait presentation ceremony is to be held - the Court is in session and their Lord Warden, Sir Winston Churchill goes on to platform for the ceremony
2. Silent cut-in shots of Viscount Montgomery and some of the Mayors to fit in during speeches.
3. The Speaker -the Mayor of Hastings, Alderman F.T.Hussey - rises to open the proceedings for the presentation
4. Short excerpts from his speech and the unveiling of the portrait which is of Sir Winston in the uniform of Lord Warden of the Cinque Ports
5. Sir Winston makes his reply

The Hastings Winkle Club ceremony

Sir Winston is made a member of the Winkle Club and the ceremony is held at Winkle Club Island which is in the old part of the town of Hastings. To become a member he is presented with a replica of a winkle made of solid gold ( the value of gold being just over £17) and the presentation is made by Bunk Harffrey, a founder member and secretary of the club.

1. Long lens on the open car arriving at Winkle Island (Mr. Farmer has done the general views to lead up to this)
2. Bunk Harffrey makes the presentation amidst a bit of a kaffuffle with the Mayor getting in the way at the beginning
3. Bunk makes a long spiel ( I thought he would never end) and then makes the gift of the gold winkle.
4. Sir Winston makes a reply ( by this time I was practically out of film) and then Montgomery calls for 'Winkles up!'
5. Car drives away.
