The nation gets a look inside the Air Force's tough and controversial "school of survival." All these men - prisoners and captors are Americans. And this is happening at Smed Air Force Base near Eeno, Nevada, where airmen are trained to resist Communist brainwashing.

Students "captured" in the hills are questioned relentlessly by hostile-uniformed officers in a grim, brain-washing style interview:

"The hole" is one of the torture devices installed at the survival school to give students a taste of Communist persuasion methods.
