They are helped financially in some cases by local authorities, Rotary clubs, various cripple aid associations, and in some cases by the village from which they come. It costs 5.5.0. for adults and 3.3.0. and 2.2.0. for children.

The heavy lifting is done by firemen, St. Johns, and Red Cross men whon all volunteer to heap.

The Manager of the Gorleston Holiday Camp virtually turns over the whole camp for a fortnight to the N.V.A.W.P.H. and also helps by interesting his easte campers during the season and getting financial help from them.

People in the town are very generous with car rides, and help provide outings on the river and in coaches and taxis.
