The Tattoo will go on from September 30th to October 13th under the *JOINT* patronage of H.M. ^{ship}QUEEN ELIZABETH II of GREAT BRITAIN and H.M. KING FREDERIK IV of DENMARK.

The magnificent BRITISH MILITARY TATTOO was opened with an immense crowd of 16.000 enthusiastic Danes.

The TATTOO was arranged in connection with opening of the BRITISH TRADE FAIR.

The programme contained:XXXXXXXXXX a fanfare
entry of all the bands i.e.
THE ROYAL MARINES
THE COLDSTREAM GUARDS
THE BUFFS
THE BLACKWATCH, and
THE GORDON HIGHLANDERS.

Thereafter the show included a competition of assembling of Jeeps between two groups of ROYAL ELECTRICAL and MECHANICAL ENGINEERS, and HIGHLAND DANCE by the SCOTCH REGIMENTS.

The DANISH ROYAL LIFE GUARD with Orchestra performed a drill.

The ROYAL CORPS OF SIGNALS had an outstanding motorcycle performance, and the zenith (culmination) of the lovely September night show was the combined BAGPIPES and DRUMS from the BRITISH COMMONWEALTH.

The evening ended up by the SUNSET-CALL and the DANISH and ENGLISH NATIONAL HYMNS.
