ROLL # 1- (100')-

LS- Scenes of flood conditions along Bronx River Parkway from falls at Bearsdale to White Plains.

MC V- Sewer erupting in Geyser along Bronx River Parkway.

Cars moving from closed Sawmill River parkway and splashing through flooded side roads.

ROLLS- 2-3-4 (300')-

Aerial shots from Norton to Norwalk, Conn. Train wreck is freight derailed at Norton on main line. Same location washout of bridge under tracks which still spans water. Factories and homes inundated along river in Norwalk. Bridge washed out.

- CAN 1 Cut in shots at Cold Spring Road Bridge showing the Rippoun River flooding the Severance St. area in West Stamford. This is a residential section of Stamford which was very hard hit.
- CAN 2 Additional cut in shots at Cold Spring Bridge showing the Severance St. area. CU and Bridge shots.
- CAN 3 Cut in shots at the West Main St. Bridge area which is the West section of Stamford proper. This bridge a steel one, services both sides of the river in the West End section.
- CAN 4 Reef Cut in shots showing the area above and at the Main St. Bridge area in Stamford. We are still on the West Side of the river and there is quite a park area with benches here.
- CAN 5 Cut in shots above Main St. Bridge around concrete bridge that crosses the Rippoun. (taken from east side of river)
Additional cut in shots showing West Stamford Bridge taken from East side of river.
- CAN 6 Additional cut in shots of Main St. Bridge in DE taken from East side of river. Cut in shots of downtown Stamford (center of town showing square, Statue, etc.) (there may be an cut in shot around the Kleevingdale store area).
- CAN 7 Cut in shots around the Kleevingdale store area showing the (what was) park area in the DE, all covered with water. Cut in shot showing the DE SOTO plowing thru the water. Cut in shot showing it making a turn at the Kleevingdale store corner. Another cut in showing the park area in DE.

Fall credit should be given to the National Guard, CB, Army, Coast Guard and Local Police for their work in evacuations and rescue work. We received 100% cooperation from all of them.
