Cambridge University confers on a great man the honorary degree of Doctor of Laws - 80 year old Doctor Albert Schweitzer. O.M. Half a century ago, he was already world-famous both as a philosopher and as a musician. To these attainments he added a medical degree, and left Europe to found a leper hospital in Africa, where he has worked ever since. An outstanding citizen of the world, Britain is proud to honour him.
