ANDES RAILROAD,

High in the Andes - over, around and even through the mountain peaks - Roundor is forging the final rail link between its cepital of Quite and the Pacific ceast. Non, not machines, are the backbone of this job. Bridges have to be made, and the living reak drilled and blasted to make a path for the railway to follow.

New obstacles arise every day. A pile of heavy timber slips, and a workman hangs on for dear life.

Almost a hundred siles of track will have been laid when the £7,000,000 project is completed early next year, and the trains begin the run through the mountain ranges which tower above this ancient land of the Inces.
