PARKING PROBLEM.

Britain's traffic problem grows week by week - and the worst problem of all is London. More private cars are on the road than ever - and they all seem to want to be in the same place at the same time. Half those drivers are thinking: where on earth can I park?

In Milan they have the same headache - but they've found one way at least of making it easier; they park them underground. Eight automatic gates admit cars to this subterranean garage, which can hold 500 cars and shift them in or out at a rate of four a minute.

Each car is taken to a lift, and from then on it's all automatic. First the car is slid off into the lift on a "dolly", which jacks it securely in place as the lift gates close.

The garage has several floors, and the lift moves up, down or sideways until it finds a vacant space. No scraped wings, no wrenched steering and no lost tempers.

Here's a space - and the machinery does the rest.
