IKE BACK AT WORK.

President Eisenhower arrives at Camp David, his mountain retreat in Maryland, for his first Cabinet meeting since his heart attack. An Air Force helicopter, nicknamed the "flying banana" brings Cabinet members - including Vice-President Nixon - from Washington, fifty miles away.

Secretary of State Foster Dulles arrives, then Attorney-General Brownell and Defence Secretary Wilson.

During the two-hour session, President Eisenhower thanks his colleagues for the loyal way they carried on the Cabinet's work during his illness. Steadily regaining his strength, the President resumes the reins of office.
