ARAB KING VISITS INDIA.

While Soviet leaders Bulganin and Khrushchev are still touring India, another head of state arrives in Delhi on an official visit - the ruler of the Middle Eastern kingdom of Saudi Arabia, King Ibn Saud. At the airport he is welcomed by Indian President Dr. Prasad, the Prime Minister Nehru.

Accompanying the king are his Crown Prince, his Prime Minister, and several Cabinet Ministers; so we can take it that this is not merely a courtesy visit. India and the Arab states have much in common, and are both having an increasing influence on world affairs.
