A hundred years ago, David Livingstone discovered the magnificent Victoria Falls on the Zambesi river. Today, at his memorial on the edge of the Falls, his Grandson, Dr. Robert Wilson, unveils a plaque recalling the achievements of the great Scottish missionary.
