ACES' CROSS COUNTRY IN LILLE WON BY NORRIS
Also covered by Fox Movietone
Positive developed : 20 meters = 67 ft

In spite of heavy rains falling 4 hours before the start the International cross country in Lille was extremely speedy.

The britishers Sando and Norris gave a good race, although it looked more like an easy walk to victory. They only kept their eyes on two Nord-Africans AMEUR and ADDECHE their most dangerous adversaries.

The course was on three tours on a three-kilometers track with several ditches and woods. After the first lap AMEUR and ADDECHE launched their attack, but NORRIS feeling the danger sped away and at the 6th kilometer while Sando arrived in the leading group, NORRIS kept his lead.

Either Ameur or Addeche in turn, tried to attack but they never succeeded in overtaking Norris.

In the last kilometer NORRIS, who is a better sprinter won before SANDO.

Results: Norris covered the 9 Kilometers in 30'34"
Sando, second in 30'35"
Ameur, third in 30'47"
Leenaert (Belgium) fourth
Addeche (France) fifth etc...
