The President, Chairman and Members of the Incorporated Society wish to extend their thanks to the Council of the British Man-made Fibres Federation, who have kindly made Hamilton House available for this occasion, and to Mr. A. J. C. Walters, Director of the Federation, who, with Lady Pamela Berry and Mr. Norman Hartnell, will receive Her Majesty and Her Royal Highness this afternoon.

The Incorporated Society also wishes to express its very deep appreciation to all the executives and staff of Hamilton House, for all their co-operation and help in preparing and presenting this Show.

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Today's Show to Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth The Queen Mother and Her Royal Highness The Princess Margaret includes thirty-four completely new models, all of which have been specially created by London's Top Twelve for this occasion. <u>Entirely new models</u> are marked with + on this list. Each House shows five models - four in sequence, and one as a finale.

British Fabrics are a vital talking-point in this Show. Here again, some of the materials used are making their very first appearance, so that Her Majesty and Her Royal Highness will be the first to see the new developments in British Textiles. Names of fabric manufacturers or merchants are given on this Release, and entirely new fabrics are marked +

Among the new fabrics are several from SEKERS; <u>NORMAN HARTNELL</u> shows his silk and rayon brocade in bright yellow; <u>VICTOR STIEBEL</u> shows a SEKERS silk, tinsel and acetate fabric specially created for JACQMAR; <u>RONALD PATERSON</u> shows a black Acrilan-andsilk mixture, and a blonde "blow-away" material of Acrilan-and-silk; <u>JOHN CAVANAGH</u> and <u>DIGBY MORTON</u> both use silk-and-rayon brocades by SEKERS.

WORTH is showing three magnificent new prints by ASCHER, whose new Sudan cotton print is also used by <u>DIGBY MORTON. LACHASSE</u> uses a completely new British Duchesse satin from BRADFORD & PERRIER a fabric which has taken two years to develop to its present perfection. Also shown by <u>LACHASSE</u> - a new black rebrode lace by BIRKIN and a white honeycomb pique cotton from JOHN HALL never before shown by the Couture. <u>MATTLI</u> shows a new jacquard wool jersey by JASKA, and a Delft-blue wool satin from FRENCHWAYS of Bradford. <u>MICHAEL SHERARD</u> uses a new satin from BRITISH CELANESE (whose pink acetate brocade is also shown by JOHN CAVANAGH); also new from <u>MICHAEL SHERARD</u> are a lilac-and-rose rayon from TOOTAL BROADHURST LEE, and a nylon and rayon charmeuse from CYRIL LORD (this length of fabric was specially created for the Show and is not yet in general production). JOHN CAVANAGH uses a new violet wool from DOBROYD, and an original striped silk from STEPHEN WALTERS. Linen in two weights is shown by <u>DIGBY MORTON</u> in a coat-and-dress outfit - both by WILLIAM EWART of Belfast, and the coat fabric an innovation in the U.K.

Because this Show comes right in the middle of the party season, there are many ball-gowns, dance-dresses and cocktail outfits. Many of the day-clothes shown forecast Spring trends, but several Designers, like <u>HARDY AMIES</u> show beautiful wool suits and dresses which are perfect for now. <u>MICHAEL</u>, too, uses some wonderful tweeds and velours for his day-clothes, and tops off with an evening dress of crimson satin. <u>CHARLES CREED</u>, also, shows some woollen fabrics of superb quality for his sleek coats and suits, and, for his finale, makes a sheath dress in pale bronze BIRKIN lace.
