

GAITSKELL TAKES OVER.

Mr. Hugh Gaitskell is elected Labour Party leader, easily beating Mr. Bevan and Mr. Herbert Morrison. Mr. Morrison, deputy leader under Mr. Attlee, resigns after his defeat. Mr. Gaitskell has the years on his side - only 49, he has already been Chancellor of the Exchequer, the youngest since Austen Chamberlain.
