JANET MARSHALL MURDER
RECONSTRUCTED.

Robert Avril, self-confessed murderer of Nottingham schoolteacher Janet Marshall, is brought by examining magistrate Judge Detraux to the scene of his crime. The case had baffled the French police for many months. In a nearby cemetery is buried the 29-year old Englishwoman whose cycling holiday through France ended so tragically.

On the spot where Janet died, the 43-year old tramp shows how he strangled her with a length of string. Avril claims the murder was unpremeditated, done in a moment of panic, and denies having used a club which was found near her body. Whatever the details, the answer has been found at last, to a grim mystery.
