MOLLET MORRED IN ALCTROS

Big trouble awaits French prender Gay Mollet when he visits Algiers, his first official act as head of the new Government. Thousands of French settlers gather near the city's war memorial, where Monaicur Mollet is to lay a wreath. And within a few minutes, the demonstration develops into one of the worst riots Algiers has ever seen, Algier's French minerity fear Mollet's government will follow a policy of "abendement", as they call it. Remembering their neighbours Merocco, and Temoria, they suspect Algista will be handed over to Arab nationalism,

Troops join police to quell the steadily growing tamult. By now the rioters are hundreds of thousands strong, and to break them up, thar gas books are brought into action.

Casualties are taken be hospital as the battle rages. When news of the riots reaches Paris, the newly-appeinted Minister-Resident for Algeria, General Catroux, resigns rather than cause discord between his former courades-in-arms. He will not be easy to replace - now more headache smaits premier Guy Mellet, as he returns to France.
