CYPRUS KILLING.

While soldiers patrol Nicosia, death strikes without warning in a narrow street. Three R.A.F. men in civilian clothes were suddenly fired on by six terrorists. One died on the spot, shot in the back, the second ran to a nearby shop, where he, too, collapsed and died; the third was seriously wounded. As usual the police could find no trace who witnessed the shooting.

Indignant at these murders, many of the British community in Cyprus are demanding that negotiations be broken off with Archbishop Makarios, unless he publicly denounces such crimes.
