Indian National Congress, the majority party which now rules India was started towards the end of the 19th century. Its aim was to achieve independence for the Indians. For many years during the British rule, the Indian National Congress was declared an unlawful society. Till recently Mr. Nehru was its president but on account of pressure of work as Prime Minister of India he resigned from the same and now Mr. U.N.DHEBAR is its president. Prior to the 61st annual congress session Mr. Dhebar was taken round in the procession at Amritsar the city of Golden Temple. Millions had collected in Amritsar to witness the 4 mile long procession which carried Camels, bullocks and horse riders in front. Hundreds of decorated arches were built enroute and as the President's jeep passed through the streets of Amritsar, thousands of men and women cheered him and showered flowers on him.
