BUSSLANS CONGRESS CRITICISES STALLI.

Gathering in the Eremlin, the 20th Congress of the Soviet Communist Party springs a surprise on the world. Josef Stalin, the man whe ruled Russia for a quarter of a contury, is publicly criticised for the first time. The chitics include Premier Bulgamin, his predocessor Malenkov and Party Secretary Erembehov.

Krushchov and his colleagues tell the delegates that for 20 years the Party has suffered in all its work from one-man rule. New, they assesses, collective leadership has been restared, and wider Party democracy is premised.

The official History of the Party - largely written by Stalin, is judged "unmatisfactory" and is to be rewritten. Other Stalin writings, until now above represed, Krushebov and his colleagues describe as "scarcely hejgful". Next startling of all, many old Bolaboviks are said to have been wrengly condenned as ensuice of the people. The world waits to see what these stronge developments will meen,
