

MANCHESTER CITY v. LIVERPOOL.

The pitch is snow-covered and treacherous when Liverpool (in dark jerseys) kick off against Manchester City at Maine Road, Manchester. The visitors are soon on the attack. Inside right Arnell centres, but City's right back Leivers heads it away.

Liverpool again - Arnell heads to Jimmy Payne, his outside right. Payne shoots, but it's wide!

Now City attack, with their new experimental forward line - Bobby Johnstone at left wing, and Revie at Centre. Johnstone and Saunders fight for the ball - Johnstone gets it but that attack fails, too. Twestyman runs to clear.

Liverpool's right wing are on the move - now it's centred - a big chance for the visitors!

Billy Liddell races through and shoots - and it's in! but a long way offside. A nasty moment for the City defence - Liverpool's forward rush might well have got home.

Half time, and still no score. Manchester try to pull their socks up.

Centre forward Revie tussles with Liverpool right back Molyneux who slips on the hard ground. Revie passes to Billy Spurdle.

Spurdle shoots - but goalie Underwood saves and runs to clear upfield.

Now Liverpool try again. Jimmy Payne has the ball - he centres but Bert Trautmann clears.

And that's how it stays - a goalless draw. Neither side can press home and score, so it's one more replay on the long road to Wembley.
